





ABSTRACT SUBMISSIONS

The APASL 2020 Research Committee would like to invite you to submit your written abstract, which will be considered either for oral or poster presentation.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

All presentations at The APASL Annual Meeting 2020 will be in English.

STRUCTURE OF ABSTRACTS

Abstracts should be comprised of the following elements, with each section entered separately:

1. **Title**

The abstract title should be in initial capital/lower case, not all capitals. Title should be limited to 25 words.

2. **Author details and Affiliation**

Author's names should be supplied in the surname-first format and should be in initial capital/lower case and not all capitals. Email address should be supplied for all authors. All affiliations should contain the department, institution, city, and country.

3. **Abstract Text**

The body of abstract should be written using the following headings: Introduction, Objectives, Methods (may include subheadings such as Subjects/Participants Intervention/s, Outcome measure, etc, if necessary), Results, and Conclusion. Use standard abbreviations (spell out in full at first mention, add abbreviations in parenthesis). Use numerals for number. Abstracts should be limited to maximum of 250 words. Only online format submission of abstracts will be accepted.

4. **Format**

Use abbreviations in parentheses after the full word the first time it appears. Please use only **Times New Roman font**. Font size should be 10. Abstract must be submitted in our website www.apasl2020.org

ABSTRACT SELECTION

Abstract submission to The APASL Annual Meeting 2020 is ONLINE ONLY.

- To update your submitted abstract, please log in into your account.

- Accepted abstracts will be allocated into oral presentation or poster presentation and published in Hepatology International.
- If you have any problem on submitting abstract, please contact us via email secretariat@apasl2020.org.

ELIGIBILITY AND RULES

Which abstracts are Eligible for Submission ?

- The Research Committee will only accept original scientific material, which has not been published as an article or have been accepted for publication (including manuscripts) in printed or electronic formats upon the submission deadline.
However, abstracts presented at local, regional, or national meetings may be submitted.
- Case report is acceptable.
- Abstracts may be selected for oral or poster presentation at APASL Annual Meeting 2020.
- **Abstract Submission Deadline** on **November, 25th 2019**.
- **The Result** will be announce on **December, 25th 2019**

LATE BREAKING ABSTRACTS

- Late-breaking abstracts submission should feature the latest science that will have an immediate impact upon researchers and practitioners. Late-breaking abstracts will be reviewed by Research Committee.
- The Late-breaking submission period is not an extension to the general submission period; rather, only abstracts that contain results not available at the general abstract submission deadline will be considered. Case studies, vignettes, retrospective studies or revision to previously submitted abstracts will not be considered.
- Late Breaking Abstract will be announce soon after abstract submission deadline.

ABSTRACT SELECTION

- All abstracts will undergo review by the Research Committee.
- All abstracts will be scored by peer review based on the scientific merit according to the categories.
- The committee will determine whether abstracts will be accepted as oral or poster presentations with consideration to be given to the author's preference.

ABSTRACT WITHDRAWAL

- APASL Annual Meeting 2020 will withdraw an abstract upon written request from the submitting author.
- **After 25th November 2019**, APASL Annual Meeting 2020 cannot guarantee that a withdrawn abstract will be excluded from publication.
- Requests to withdraw an abstract must contain the submitting author's name,

- Abstract participants who have not registered until late deadline, will be withdrawn.
- If the accepted abstract have not paid the registration fee until the conference date, the accepted status of abstract will be canceled.

COMMITMENT TO PRESENT

- Submission of an abstract constitutes a commitment to present at APASL Annual Meeting 2020. All presenters must register to attend the meeting.
- If the presenting author is NOT able to attend, either the submitting or presenting author MUST contact secretariat@apasl2020.org with the name of a co-author who present the paper at the meeting. Only authors listed on the abstracts at the time of submission are eligible to present an abstract.

PUBLICATION

Abstracts selected for oral and poster presentation at APASL Annual Meeting 2020 will be published in Hepatology International .


NOTIFICATION



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GENERAL INFORMATION



CLIMATE

Indonesia is distinctly tropical. The weather in Bali in September is usually hot and humid with temperatures ranging between **28 – 32 degrees Celsius** and the **relative humidity is about 88%**. There is comparatively little difference between the day time and night time temperatures. All conference sessions will be held in air – conditioned venues.



PASSPORT & VISA

All foreigners wishing to enter Indonesia must have a Passport valid for **at least six (6) months** from the date of arrival along with proof (tickets) of onward or return passage. Please contact the Indonesia Embassy/Consulate in your country before the Conference in order to check if you require any other immigration procedures to visit Indonesia. Free Tourist Visa Free visa has been given for tourists who are nationals of a total **169 countries** who wish to travel to Indonesia. Tourist Visa Free Facilities are valid for **30 days** and it is **non-extendable** or cannot be transferred into any other type of stay permit. This countries granted Visa Free Facilities according to *Presidential Decree No. 21 of 2016*.



LETTER

Invitation letter or other necessary document to obtain Indonesian visa will be provided by the Secretariat of APASL 2020 Bali based on request to email **secretariat@apasl2020.org**. However this letter aims to assist participants for their travel to Indonesia and *does not imply any commitment for the Organization Committee to provide financial support*. Please get in touch as early as possible with the APASL 2020 Secretariat if you need an invitation letter.



AIRPORT TAX

An airport tax of **IDR 150,000** is levied by airports on departing passengers **on international flights** and **IDR 40,000 for those on domestic routes**. Most airlines today incorporate airport tax into their total tickets cost on purchase. Do make sure that this is already included.



ELECTRIC CURRENT

The electric current in use throughout Indonesia is **220 volt** at 50 cycles. In hotels, you may find two sockets for **110** and **220 volt** each; or a converter may be obtained through the housekeeping. **Power Plug 220 V**.



TAXI

Taxis are available at the airport arrival area. Fare around **IDR 250,000** or **approximately USD 19**. Make sure you take a cab from the official stand and **NOT** from someone offering taxi inside the terminal.



CUSTOMS

Maximum items allowed by customs when you visit Indonesia:

- 1 liter of alcoholic beverages
- 200 cigarettes OR 50 cigars OR 100 grams of tobacco
- Perfume the customs probably will not mind you carrying loads of bottles.
- Cameras, video cameras, portable radios, cassette recorders, binoculars and sport equipment are should be taken out during airport departure process. They must be declared to Customs.

You are **prohibited** to carry:

- Firearms
- Narcotics drugs
- Pornography materials
- Chinese printing and medicines
- Transceivers and cordless telephone
- Films, pre-recorded video tapes, laser discs, VCDs, DVDs must be screened by Censor Board.
- Import or export of foreign currencies and travelers' checks are allowed. However, the import and export of Indonesia currency, exceeding 100 million Rupiah is prohibited.

CURRENCY

USD 1.00 = IDR 13,000 | EUR 1.00 = IDR 16,500

Only Rupiah (Indonesia currency) or is acceptable at regular stores and restaurants. Most hotels, restaurants, and souvenirs shop accept certain foreign currencies and credit card. The Indonesian Rupiah is available in **note denomination of 100,000.-, 50,000.-, 20,000.-, 10,000.-, 5,000.-, 2,000,- and 1000.-.** **Coins** are available in **denomination of 1,000.-, 500.-, 200.-, and 100.-.** You can buy Rupiah at foreign exchange banks and other authorized money changers on presentation of your passport. **The exchange rate fluctuates regularly.** Check your bank for the latest exchange rates.


