Goals and objectives of the scientific event: The conference aims to present results and discuss the latest achievements in the field of alcohol-related liver damage and comorbid pathology, as well as prevention, diagnosis, and treatment. Clinical guidelines for the Asia-Pacific region will be developed based on the conference materials.



2. Number of participants in the scientific event: the conference was held online, with more than 2,000 connections in total, from 26 regions of Russia, 35 countries, and 4 continents.
3. Number of presentations: 37, of which 17 were presented by foreign speakers.
4. Publication of scientific event materials:– Hepatology International
5. The conference budget amounted to 100,000 rubles (1,200 dollars), half of which came from abstract submission fees. 34 abstracts were submitted (authors from Russia, Romania, Armenia).
